# Secretary's Report 9/10/23

Jerry presided over the meeting with 19 attending. Cheryl said membership is at 100. A new member, Dave Williford attended the meeting. The Silent and Live Auctions for Special Wish totaled \$17,312.20 & the club voted to add the additional funds to round up to \$20,000. This year was the fifth largest show with 505 total registrations, Tipp had 396, Concours 9, Winners Row 28. A total of 30 states were at the show including 2 countries & 107 were here for the first time. Vendors took up 54 spaces. There was one car for every year that a firebird was made at the show including 49 Firebirds, 44 Formulas, 378 Trans Am & 37 others.




